#### ■ Rosh Hashana Childrens Groups

Thanks to the great response from the girls of our community, we will be having Rosh Hashana groups for children: **Boys**: Ages 2 - 7 and **Girls**: Ages 2 - 9

The groups will take place both days of Rosh Hashana in Ulam Shabsai from 9 AM – 1 PM.

#### **Some Important Notes:**

- In order for a child to attend the groups, a parent (not a sibling, friend, aunt, etc.) must be present in the building at all times. If a parent is requested to come to the groups, he/she must do so immediately.
- It is a good idea to go downstairs every so often to check on your child, and if you have a rambunctious, leibedig child that likes to wander outside, etc., it would be a good idea to stay with your child.
- All children that are not toilet trained must be accompanied at groups by a parent or sibling that can change them.
- Light snacks and drinks will be available. Please tell the group leaders about any allergies
- If you send your child with a game or toy, please label it and take responsibility for it (if you want it back). Please No Balls!
- Group leaders will not, under any circumstances, give any children medicine. If there is such a need, a parent must handle the situation.
- Please do not bring children who are under the weather and contagious to groups.
- A final word: the groups are a chessed offered by the shul (and the volunteers) and is not "included" in payment for a seat. Therefore, if a child misbehaves too much (at the discretion of the group leaders) a parent may be asked to take the child out of the groups.
- Please be advised that neither the shul nor any of the volunteers takes responsibility for the safety and welfare of the children (as well as any toys). They will certainly do their best to watch the children, but there likely will be a lot of children, so parents who leave their children do so at their own risk.

Beginning with the beginning: Chevron, davening shacharis at Me'aras Hamachpeilah/kivrei Avos, hearing divrei hisorerus from the Rav taking us to the very core of tefillah, walking in the actual footsteps of our Avos, saying Tehillim by kivrei Yishai and Rus-what an opportunity and zechus.... Then, a beautiful Leil Shabbos davening, followed by a sichah by Rav Menachem Nissel (BTYA's first ever "scholar in residence" - and what a first it was - thanks to those who helped organize and to the generous sponsor l'refuah shlaimah for Miriam bas Chana) about 4 fundamental and life altering aitzos about how to daven.

The Rav's Nach shiur the next morning gave way to an insightful shiur on hilchos tefillah (ever wonder how to balance the feelings of simcha and yirah one should have while davening? Our inspiration carried over into Motzaei Shabbos with Rav Nissel's standing room only "Tefillah for the Overwhelmed" for the women of BTYA and the general RBS community, which was followed up by a very well attended and incredibly informative kashrus presentation by R' Yechiel Spira (special thanks to Ms. Chani Loring of Stroke of genius Design for a beyondwords job on the 5772 Kashrus Guide).

Finally, we were moved by the heartfelt words of Rav Avrohom Jacobovits in his pre-selichos sichah on the enigma of selichos on Motzaei Shabbos, which transformed our selichos, led by R' Refael Willig, to tefillos of a new height and depth. May we be zocheh to take all the lessons we learned over Shabbos and use them in our Yomim Nora'im tefillos and merit a shana tova u'mesuka.
